

Ask Rocky River Fence Extension

Rocky River Council is coming to the aid of home owners below the new Lakewood-Rocky River span just as yachting club officials did for boat owners. "A precedent might have been set for bridges over navigable waters by setting up a wire fence over the river but what about the occupants of homes?" Councilman Dan H. Andrews of the suburb said.

ANDREWS was commenting on installation of 1,000 feet of wire fencing to keep young hoodlums from throwing objects onto passing boats.

"There are 30 homes on Island Drive, Riverdale Drive and Yacht Club Drive which also could be bombarded with flying objects," he said.

He said another 400 feet of fencing should be installed, 200 feet on each side, over the homes. "They say it cost about \$8,000 to save the boat owners so it should not cost much more than \$2,000 extra to protect the home owner so he can walk in his own driveway," Andrews said.

THE FENCING NOW is only over the river. As a result, Law Director Thomas E. Allen drew up a resolution addressed to the county commissioners and the Ohio Department of Highways asking an extension of the fence.

OLMSTED Sewer Plant Site Appraised
A Rocky River firm has appraised eight acres of land being considered as a site for an Olmsted Falls sewage disposal plant at \$2,500 an acre.

The property, at 6889 Columbia Road and owned by Peter J. Petto Sr., has no access road. The village Council last night asked for an appraisal on a right-of-way to the parcel. It will also seek two additional appraisals.

EUCLID Jaycees Plan Memorial Light
The Euclid Junior Chamber of Commerce is contemplating erection of an eternal light in memory of the late President John F. Kennedy at Euclid Memorial Park, near City Hall, it was announced yesterday by Richard Burrows, Jaycee president.

Burrows said the group is working with the East Ohio Gas Co., which has contacted the Washington gas company. The Jaycees are aiming at a replica of the eternal light in Arlington Park Cemetery near the late President's grave. "We could build one ourselves but we would like to give people and industries a chance to work with us in this tribute," Burrows said. Donations from both labor and industry for the materials will be accepted. Size of the memorial will depend on the donations.

Scope of HIGHLAND HTS. Probe Set
Highland Heights Council has established the scope of an investigation it will make Dec. 10 into charges that appeared in the campaign literature of Mayor Robert Barris. The charges stated that the Council favored one company in accepting bids for the purchase of the village's gasoline supply, and that the Council paid \$1,500 for sewer plans that never were used. Barris, who was defeated in his bid for reelection, has been asked to attend the hearing.

PARMA Contracts for School Addition
Contract for an eight-classroom addition to Dentzler School in Parma yesterday was awarded by the Parma school board to the Dorer-Buettell Inc., 3690 E. 93rd Street, general contractors, on a bid of \$117,331. Schools Superintendent Paul W. Briggs said that is the lowest bid for a classroom addition of that size in his experience. He credited good planning by Emil Biskup Associates, architects.

The board also selected John F. Lipaj to design both of the new elementary schools in Parma, one near State and Pleasant Valley Roads and the other adjacent to Pleasant Valley Junior High, 9906 Pleasant Valley Road.

Bid for School Use of Crile Is Weighed

Communities in southwest Cuyahoga County may be sending resolutions to Washington that would call for an education-science center on the site of the Crile Veteran's Administration Hospital. The hospital buildings and 400-acre site, most of it in Parma, probably will be vacated by next June. The facility is being moved to new quarters on East Boulevard N. E. and E. 105th Street.

The proposal for an education-science center was discussed last night at a meeting of the Parma Planning and Zoning Committee.

Ronald M. Mott, president of the Parma Council and acting chairman of the planning and zoning committee, suggested that the prospective campus be sought hurriedly along with the \$100-million National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) electronics facility.
